WHAT IS IT?

- Computer-based sharing of parts of your medical record between your GP surgery and:
 - Out of Hours services
 - Ambulance Service
 - o NHS24 (#111)
 - A&E/hospitals
- Your GP can create an KIS
 with your consent or the
 consent of your main carer
 if you are unable to
 consent

WHAT IS INCLUDED?

- Summary of your main health problems
- Medications & allergies
- Living situation and how you manage normally
- Key Professionals involved in your care
- Next of Kin details who you would like to be contacted in an emergency
- Power of Attorney details
- Your wishes for your care if you became unwell
- Resuscitation wishes

WHO CAN BENEFIT?

- Anyone who has:
 - Long term condition or complex health needs
 - Multiple medications
- Anyone likely to need:
 - Care / medical attention at the weekends or out of hours
- Anyone who may find it difficult to give details in an emergency due to:
 - Memory problems
 - Mental health problems
 - Communication problems
 - Learning difficulties/disabilities

WHY IS IT IMPORTANT?

- Making sure your wishes are taken into account in planning your treatment and care
- Reducing the risk of care being given to you that you do not wish
- Improving patient safety
- Quick transfer of important information between health professionals
- Enables easy access to details for emergency contacts if you become unwell
